To the Men and Women of NASSCO-Norfolk,


Today we were notified that a member of our NASSCO-Norfolk team has tested presumptive positive for the COVID-19 virus. I would like to take a few moments to update you on our fight against this virus and what we're doing to address the concerns we all share.

For our presumptively positive employee, this individual has not been at work since March 24th (12 days ago) and will remain at home until given the recommendation from their doctor to return to work. This employee works in the pipe shop (X56) and anyone known to have close personal contact with this person will be notified as soon as possible. For this case, we are following the containment guidance from the CDC, including the necessary cleaning and sanitizing of the shop area.

Like all of you, I am concerned about all NASSCO-Norfolk families. It is critically important that we all play an active role in reducing the risk to ourselves and those around us. We must continue to practice proper hygiene, social distancing, and the recommended guidelines as we fight together in this war against COVID-19.
