TO: All Non Uniformed Personnel Accessing NASSCO-Norfolk Facilities

SUBJECT: Enhanced COVID-19 Screening at NASSCO-Norfolk

As a part of NASSCO-Norfolk's continued efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of our employees, and other personnel entering our facilities, we will be implementing additional resources and screening measures. We ask for your continued cooperation and assistance in helping us minimize the spread of COVID-19.

Beginning on Wednesday, April 22, 2020:

NASSCO-Norfolk will conduct voluntary and random, non-invasive temperature checks using no-touch infrared thermometers at the main entrances to our Ligon and Harper shipyards. These random checks will be conducted at clearly marked stations that will be located before entry to the turnstile area at each facility.

Studies have found that individuals may not always know they have a fever, which the CDC defines as any temperature at or over 100.4° F [38° C]. The purpose of these stations will be to provide individuals with screening information concerning COVID-19, and to assure temperature checks are available for anyone seeking a quick assessment using a no-touch infrared thermometer.

Thank you for keeping our NASSCO-Norfolk team safe as we continue our operations in support of the United States Navy. If you are sick or have any symptoms of COVID-19, including shortness of breath, persistent coughing or fever, stay home and call your health care provider for further medical information.
